1. VISITORS ARE REQUIRED


- Make yourself familiar with the Environmental Health & Safety information of the school.

- Sign in and out of the logbook at Reception when working in a laboratory


2. ENVIRONMENT HEALTH & SAFTEY

- Safety Information is available on Safety Boards located in the lift foyer spaces on each floor.
- Laboratory managers are responsible for local inductions and training in laboratories before providing access to the space and use of equipment.

3. EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- In any life-threatening situation, always call Victorian emergency services first via **000** (0 000 from a university landline), then call University Security.
- Contact University Security at any time by calling 834 46666 or 1800 246 066 (free call).
- A telephone to call internal extensions is available at Reception.
- The David Caro building has a fire alarm (bell and siren) to signal evacuation. Always follow the instructions of University Staff during an evacuation.
- Assemble and remain at the designated assembly areas with University Staff:





4. GENERAL INFORMATION

- The School of Physics Reception is located on level 1, opposite the main entry to the building off the corner of Swanston Street/Tin Alley.
- The office is open from 10am 2pm. There is continual telephone cover on 834 40585 or email <u>physics-adminstaff@unimelb.ed.au</u>. There is a telephone available outside reception for dialing internal extensions or security.
- The external doors of the building are open during business hours (7am 6pm). Outside these hours, your host must facilitate access where required. Bathroom facilities are available on every floor, except Level 1, near the elevators.
